



Watterson is currently designing and constructing a four story, 85,000sf office addition to the existing Consortium Office Building located on the Anchorage, ANTHC campus.

The Healthy Communities Building will be certified LEED Silver by USGBC. Materials were selected with an eye towards reducing the operational costs of the building, its impact on the earth and


