As of 2018, 31 years of the tournament have been played in Coral Springs and Broward County, Florida. The tournament may be one of the longest running amateur sports events in Florida.

The NATIONAL MASTERS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS TOURNAMENT evolved from the NATIONAL AAU MEN'S MASTER'S CHAMPIONSHIP

The first AAU Men's Master's Basketball Championship was held in Jacksonville, Florida, May 2 - 5, 1985. The original concept for the tournament was to have 2 divisions; 35 years of age and over and 45 years of age and over. As it worked out, a 30 years and over and 45 years and over competition was held. During 1986, 3 divisions were established for the championship; 30 and over, 40 and over and 50 and over. In 1987, five divisions were planned (30 and over, 35 and over, 40 and over, 45 and over and 50 and over). The 45 and over g roup was not used. In 1988, five divisions were established. They were 30 and over, 35 and over, 40 and over, 40 and over, 45 and over and 55 and over. In 1993 a sixth division of 60 years of age and over was established. In 1996 a seventh division of 30 and above was added. In 1999 an eighth division of 65 and above was added. Many teams and players return year after year to our premier tournament, looking forward to the comaraderie, competition and MBA experience, allowing for more age divisions to be added.

For 2019, the MBA is offering seven divisions: Men's 40-49, 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+, and 75+.

The MBA tournament has a number of awards for both team and individual player recognition.

Sportsman of the Year

Our Sportsman of the Year award recognizes an individual who, over a number of years of participation in the tournament, has come to symbolize the very best qualities of sportsmanship and competitive fair play. This award is considered the most prestigious award given. The recipient of this award is given a commemorative plaque, a MBA Tournament ring. Candidates for this special award should be directed to the Tournament Director who will forward nominee information to the Sportsman Selection Committee of the MBA Board of Directors for consideration.

Team Awards

Attractive awards are given to the Team Organizers or Coaches of first- and second-place teams in the Championship Finals and to those who win the Consolation Finals.

Player Awards

Each player in a Championship team will receive an award for being on the championship team. Players on the second place team will also receive a unique award.

All Tournament Teams


An "All Tournament" team comprised of 10 players is named for each age division. After each preliminary and semi-final game, tournament staff select players who have had an "All Tournament" type performance. These votes are tallied at the end of the week and the top 10 vote getters in each age division are named to an "All Tournament" team. Each of these players will be presented with an award recognizing their accomplishment.

Most Valuable Player Awards

The very prestigious Gordon D. Pope MVP Ring by Jostens, designed especially for the MBA is awarded to the MVP from each Age Division. The ring is highly coveted and treasured by the winners.

A committee from the South Florida Basketball Fraternity selects MVP's. Each man knows the game very well having played, coached and observed many basketball games over the years. MVP's are as a rule, chosen from the Championship teams.




